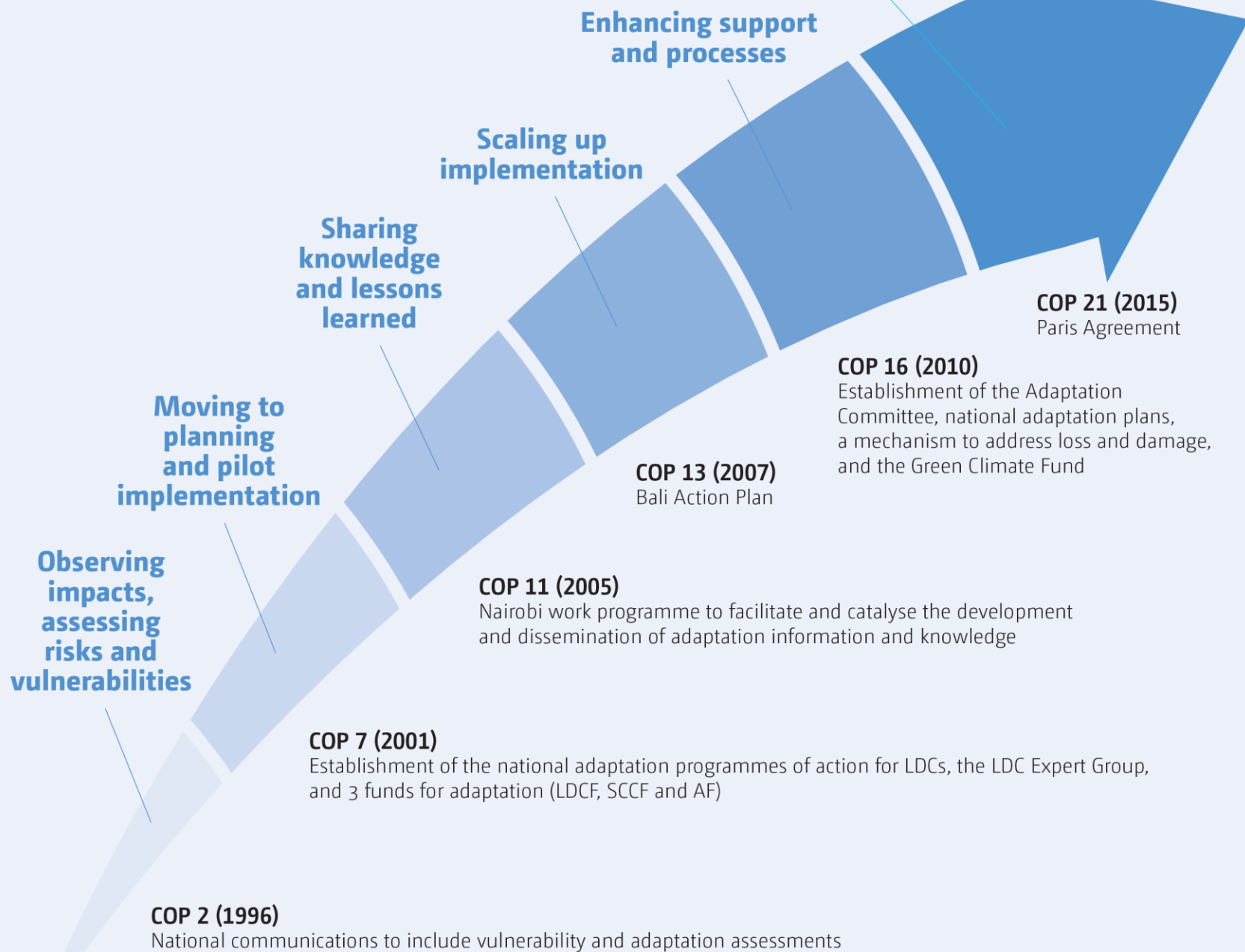

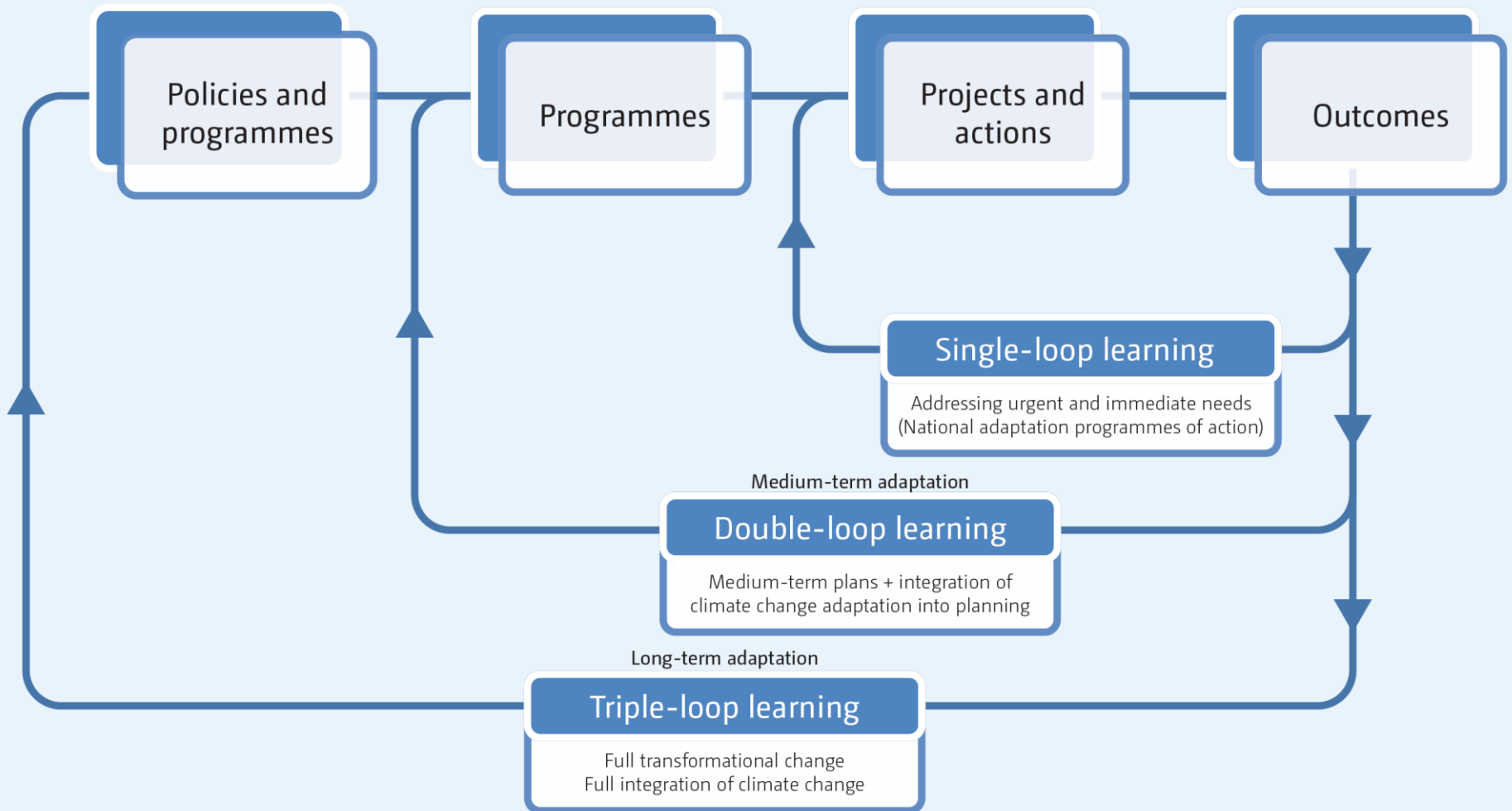

## Adapting in the future



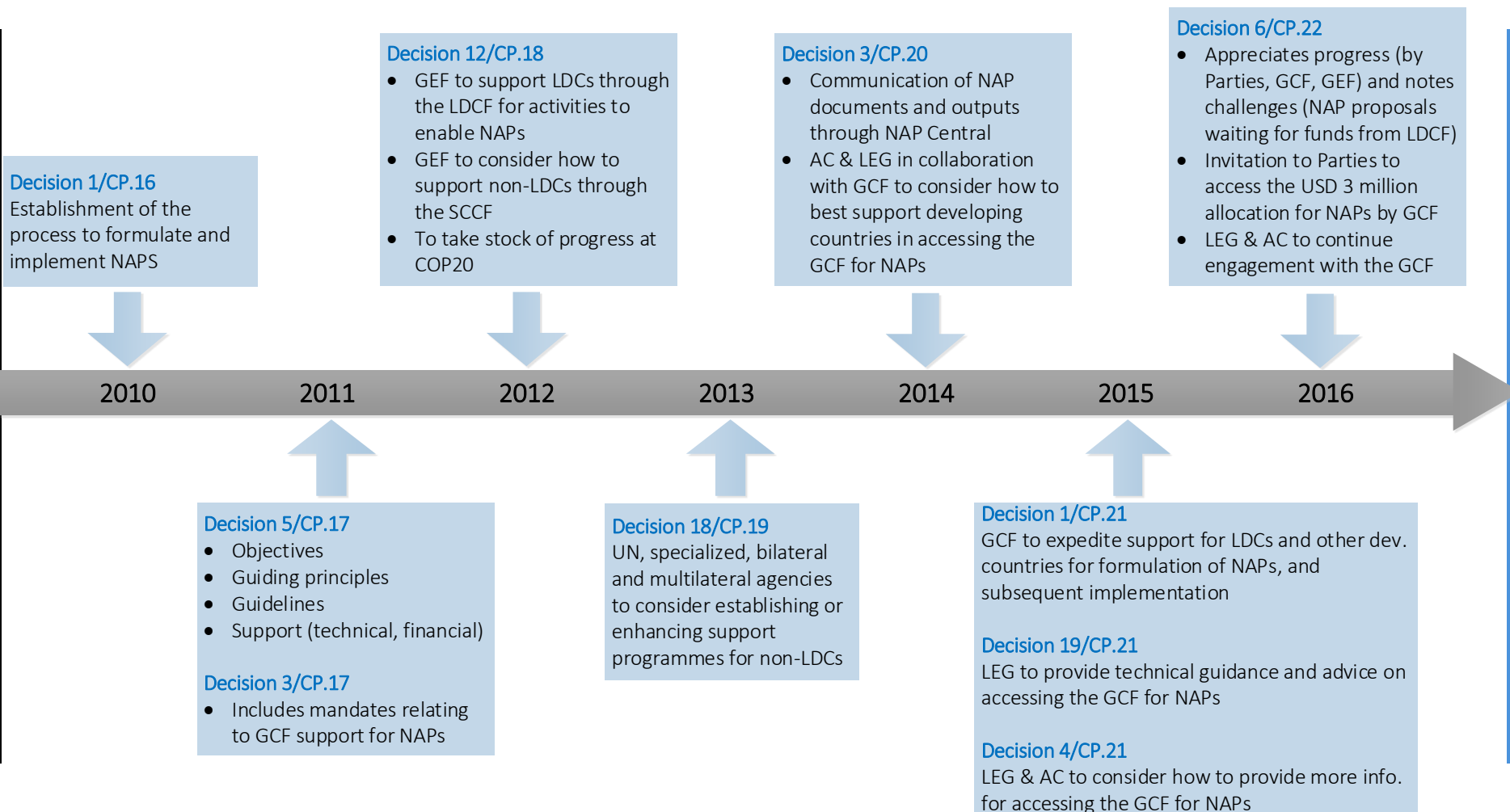
## Learning loops for adaptation (source: LEG BP&LL Vol 3)

# COP decisions on NAPs



## Evolving guidance on national adaptation plans

---

- ❑ Since establishment (in 2010), the LEG continues to explore with partner agencies, how to refine the technical guidelines - through supplements, the integrating framework, etc.
  - ❖ Includes guidance on how to integrate SDGs into NAPs, as well as Sendai and other international, regional and national frameworks
  - ❖ M&E of the process using the PEG M&E Tool
  - ❖ Work on adaptation solutions for main systems
  - ❖ Etc.



## National adaptation plans

---

- ❑ NAPs are the main vehicle for undertaking adaptation from 2010 onwards
- ❑ They provide a means to scale up adaptation to the national level, with flexibility for countries to follow a country-driven road map to arriving at the NAP, including on whether they start with an integrated approach then sectors, or sectors then an integrated approach
- ❑ The NAP is the primary instrument help countries manage their work on adaptation, at all scales and levels into a coherent national approach.
- ❑ Designed to be a long-term approach that produces plans regularly, and get implemented, monitored, revised, scaled out to more sectors over time

- ❑ Implementation
- ❑ Need for learning from various events, to find a way to capture this learning and inform design of new adaptation solutions:
  - ❖ The recent major storms/flooding in Bangladesh, Nepal, Mumbai, Caribbean, USA, etc.;
  - ❖ Flooding in many coastal cities (Manila, Nadi etc.)
- ❑ Reporting - SBI, COP, PA
