## Stakeholder identification table

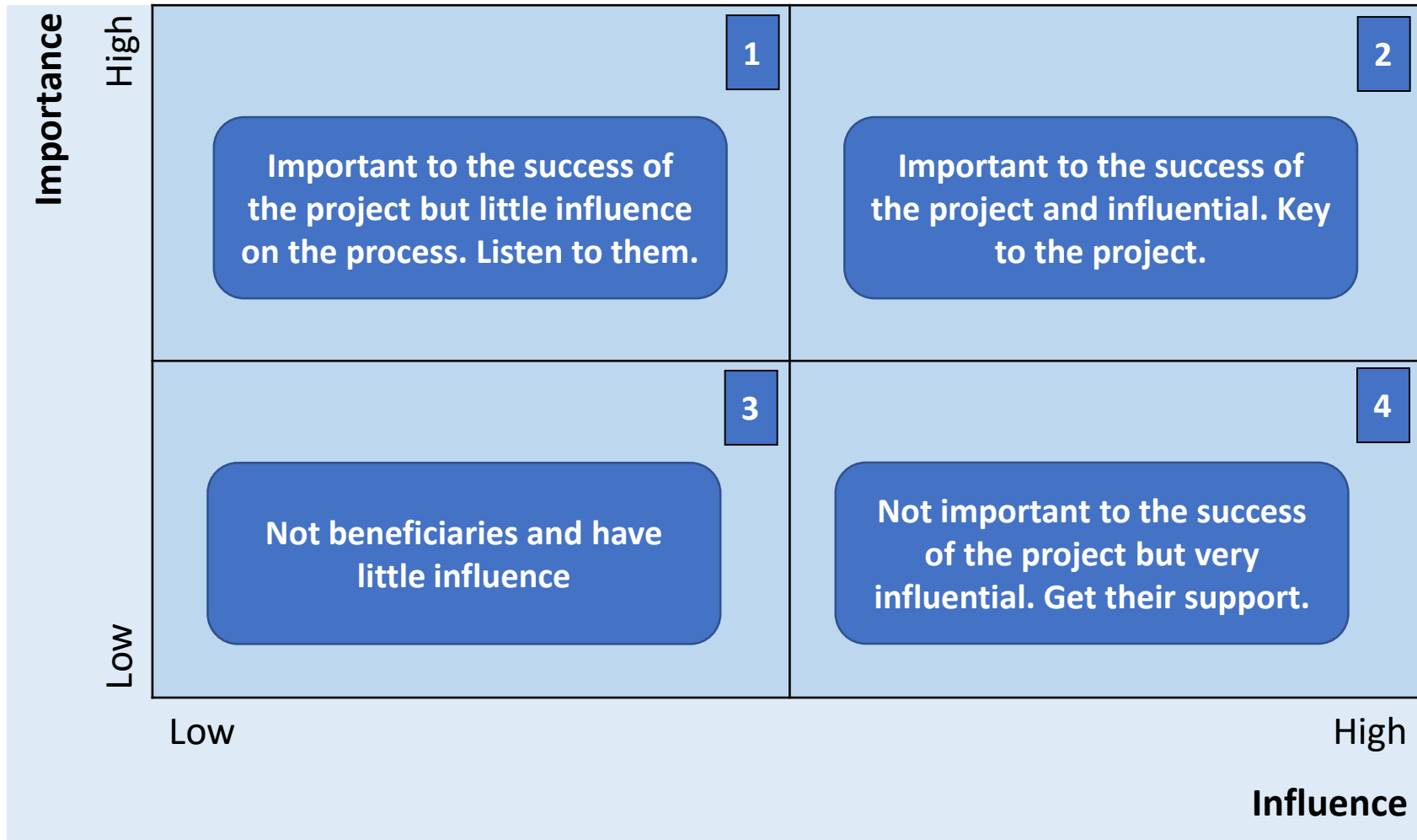
Stakeholder	Reason for interest	Nature of interest (+/-)	Importance (1 to 5, 5 = highest)	Influence (1 to 5, 5 = highest)
<i>Private landowners</i>	<i>Need to obtain financial return</i>	–	4	4

**Nature of interest:** Supportive or against the project?

**Importance:** Important to success of the project

**Influence:** What control do they have over the project design or implementation?

# Stakeholder influence-importance map

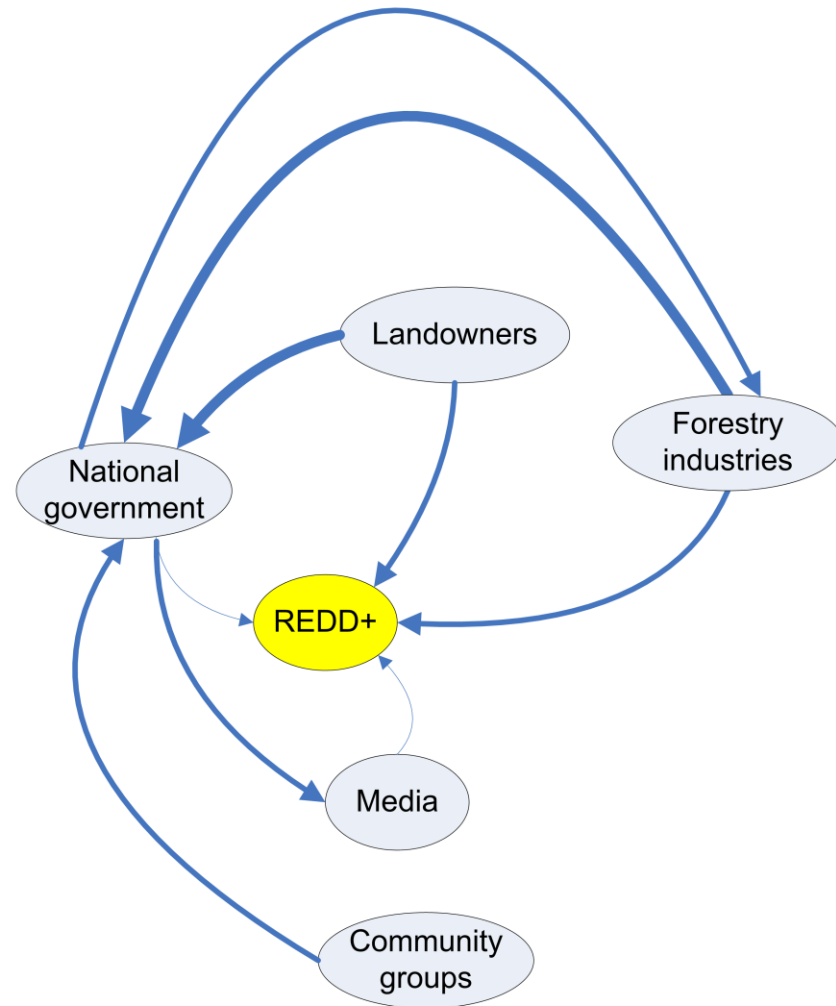


# Stakeholder influence diagram
